MENS AFFILIATED SECTION COMMITTEE
CONDITIONS FOR ENTRIES FOR CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS 2011-2012

- ◆ Where teams are entered for pairs and triples, the skippers are responsible for submitting the entries and paying the applicable fees.
- ◆ Only affiliated members of Armadale Bowls Club, who are eligible to represent Armadale in Pennant Competitions for 2011-2012, may enter the Club Singles, Minor Singles, Club Pairs, Triples and Fours. Men and ladies entering in the Mixed Pairs must meet the foregoing criteria.
- ◆ Any member who has won a Club Singles, Pairs, Triples or Fours Championship at Armadale Bowls Club, or any other Bowls Club, which has resulted in them achieving Master status, is **NOT ELIGIBLE** to enter the Minor Singles Event.
- ◆ Members entering either the Club Singles or the Minor Singles shall be expected, within reason, to act as markers for other entrants.
- ◆ The closing date for entries for the Club Singles, Minor Singles, Club Pairs, Mixed Pairs and the Club Triples is Sunday 2 October 2011. The draws for all these events will be on display from 6 October 2011.
- ◆ The reservation of rinks for games must be entered on the Tournament/Events clip-board in the shed closest to the Club House. Reservation sheets will be available from 6 October 2011.
- ◆ The Club Fours competition will be announced (if at least 8 teams enter) at the start of 2012.
- ◆ **Late entries and entries without the applicable entry fee/s will not be accepted.**

RULES FOR CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS AND EVENTS 2011-2012

- ◆ **All Club Championship events are to be played in club uniform. Markers also to be in club uniform – no exceptions.**
- ◆ The final dates for the playing of each round for all Club Events, are clearly shown on the front of the Entry Form. **Members who have not completed their games by those dates, will be excluded from further participation in that event.**
- ◆ **It is not permissible for a member to practice or take part in a social game before playing in a Club competition on the same day – By Law 2.1**
- ◆ No Singles game may be played without a marker and it is the responsibility of the players to arrange a marker for their game.
- ◆ The first round of the Pairs Event will be played **ON Sunday 9 October 2011**. This is to ensure that the final will be played on Sunday 18 December, and enable the winners to enter in the Victorian Champion of Champions event.
- ◆ In Pairs games it is the responsibility of the two skippers to determine which of them will reserve a rink for play.
- ◆ If a team member is **UNAVAILABLE** to play in an arranged game, then a substitute may be arranged. In the event that no substitute is arranged then that team shall **FORFEIT** the game.
- ◆ If inclement weather on the final day for the playing of games prevents any play, then the Tournament Committee will grant an extension of time for the members concerned, to 4pm on the following Thursday. No extensions of time for the completion of games will be granted for any other reason or occurrence.
- ◆ The Tournament Committee appointed by the Men's Section Committee, shall be the final arbiter in all matters, issues and disputes associated with the Club Championships and Events; and reserves the right to change these Conditions and Rules if deemed necessary; and to amend the dates shown as the final dates for rounds and finals, if circumstances so dictate.
