The manager says, 'I want those two back in the office after lunch.'

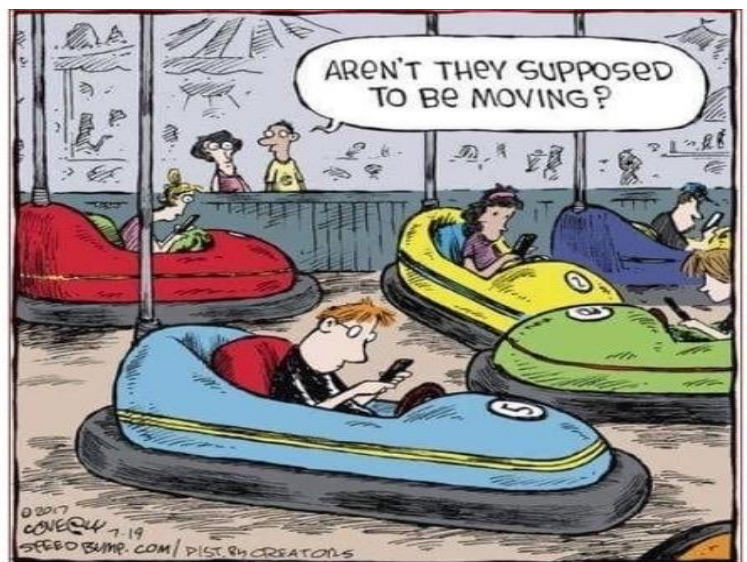
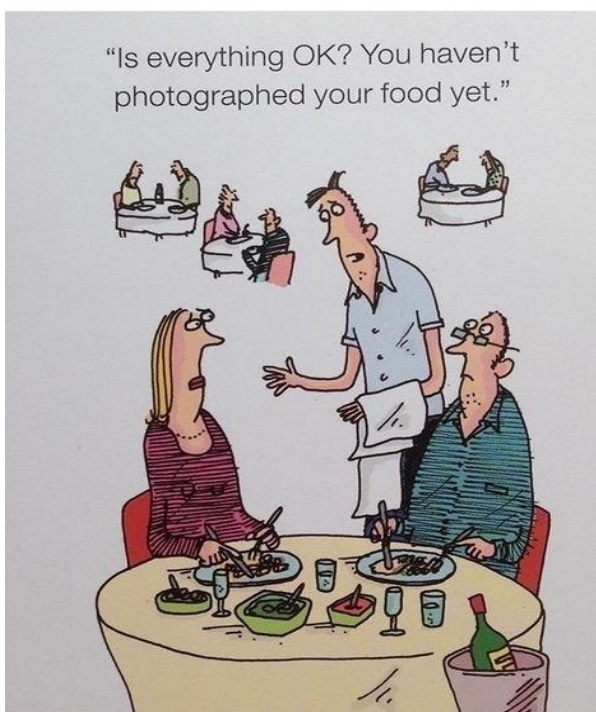
