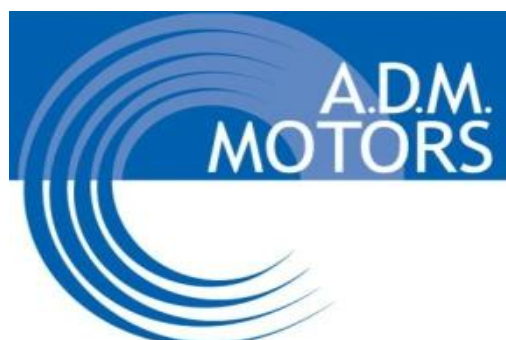

Last Saturday Pennant Game is Saturday March 4th 2017 but Finals don't finish till Saturday 25th March 2017.

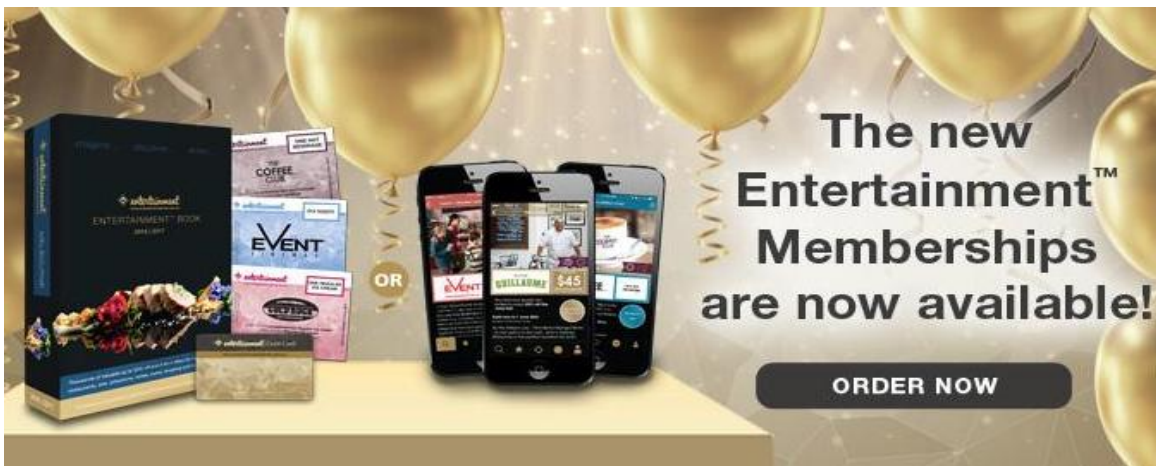

Good News that Trevor Battersby is back home and says he will be back at the club soon.

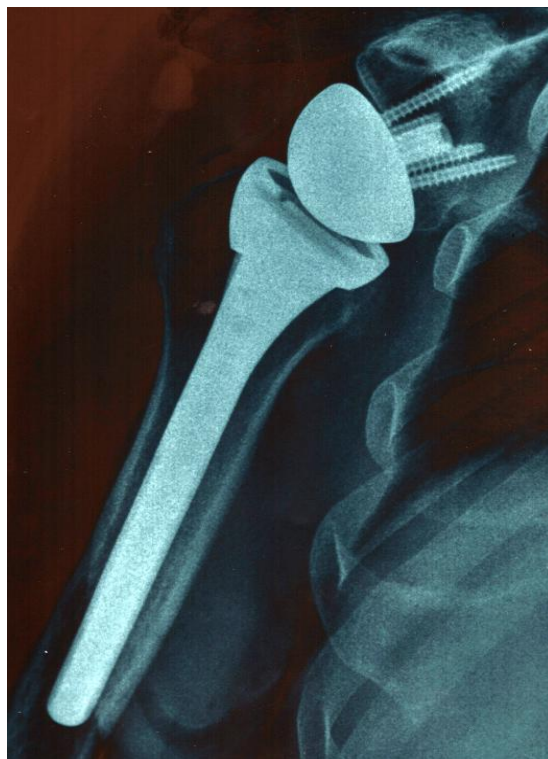
LETTER FROM MERV BARNETT

- **STICK OUT YOUR TONGUE! - NEW SIGN OF STROKE**
