## COACHES CORNER-FINAL

In past Coaches Corner Articles in the Club Newsletters there have been a few articles covering various issues concerning bowling by Hunny Lipson, Leon Cohen, Bernard Levin, Wolfe Groch, Denise Brick and Myself.

All of the information in those articles is very important.

With the finals approaching fast, every player needs to focus on every aspect of their delivery routine in order to delivery bowls that count both in practice and more particularly in the game.

When planning their shots, players are entitled to ask the Skip the location of the Jack and the position of the relevant bowls that they may be concerned about. It is up to the Skip to clearly indicate the shot to be played and the position in which he wants a bowl to finish. The Skips should analyse the head, best in consultation with the Thirds, before leaving it, and plan the shots accordingly and ask his third to indicate finishing positions for the bowls they put down.

This is called TEAMWORK as is the Lead rolling the Jack to the required length and putting one bowl on the Jack and one behind. The Second putting supporting bowls in order to build the head in Armadale's favour and even removing opposition shot bowls with a SLIGHT overdraw as required.

Player and teams play well and play to win, make every shot count.

I wish all players the best of success in the coming finals.
